School Uniform Policy

Introduction

At Milford Haven Community Primary School we believe that a school uniform is important because it:

- Contributes to a sense of belonging
- Gives a common purpose
- Fosters a feeling of pride
- Looks smart
- Wears well

We ask that all children wear the Milford Haven Community School uniform.

What is the Milford Haven Community School uniform?

Our school uniform is as follows:

Red or white polo shirts (with or without the school logo)

Red and white sundress

Red sweatshirt, hoodie, cardigan or fleece jacket (with the school logo)

30x5 and other sporting activities

As a result of the introduction of 30x5, which sees all pupils and staff participate in 30 minutes of exercise, 5 days per week. We have relaxed our original policy on trousers and school shoes. To ensure pupils are ready to take part each day, we encourage pupils to wear:

- Tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts.
- Sensible shoes for exercising which includes trainers.

Pupils in our Year 5 and 6 year groups are encouraged to bring a change of top (t-shirt) to take part in these, as well as roll on deodorant only. They will be given this time to change their top before and then back to uniform tops after the session.

All pupils have swimming lessons when in key stage 2. Swimming caps must be worn during these lessons as this is the policy of the Leisure Centre. It is school policy for girls to wear only one-piece swimwear.

Jewellery

We request that any piercings are stud only piercings to avoid accident or injuries that hooped piercings can cause.

We kindly ask that pupils do not wear necklaces, bracelets and rings to school to avoid injury during sports and more practical activities. Pupils wearing rings will be requested to remove them before these types of activities.

Purchasing the Milford Haven Community School uniform

It is important to us that uniform does not provide an additional financial pressure for our families. This is why we request that school jumpers, hoody, cardigans are purchases with the school badge and always worn during school trips. School polo shirts are not required to have the school badge.

The above items, with the school logo, can be purchased from our suppliers (Granbys Menswear, Milford Haven and KJ Prints, Haverfordwest).

The above items can also be purchased, without the school logo, from other shops and stores.

Please Remember....

- Parents are asked to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with their child's name.
- For safety reasons we ask that the children do not wear jewellery in school. If earrings are to be worn then they must be studs.

The Governors and Staff hope that parents choosing to send their children to Milford Haven Community Primary School will support the 'ethos' of the school by ensuring they send their child to school in agreed school uniform.
